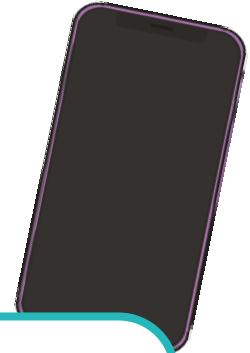

Grown-ups can help you to use the Internet safely.



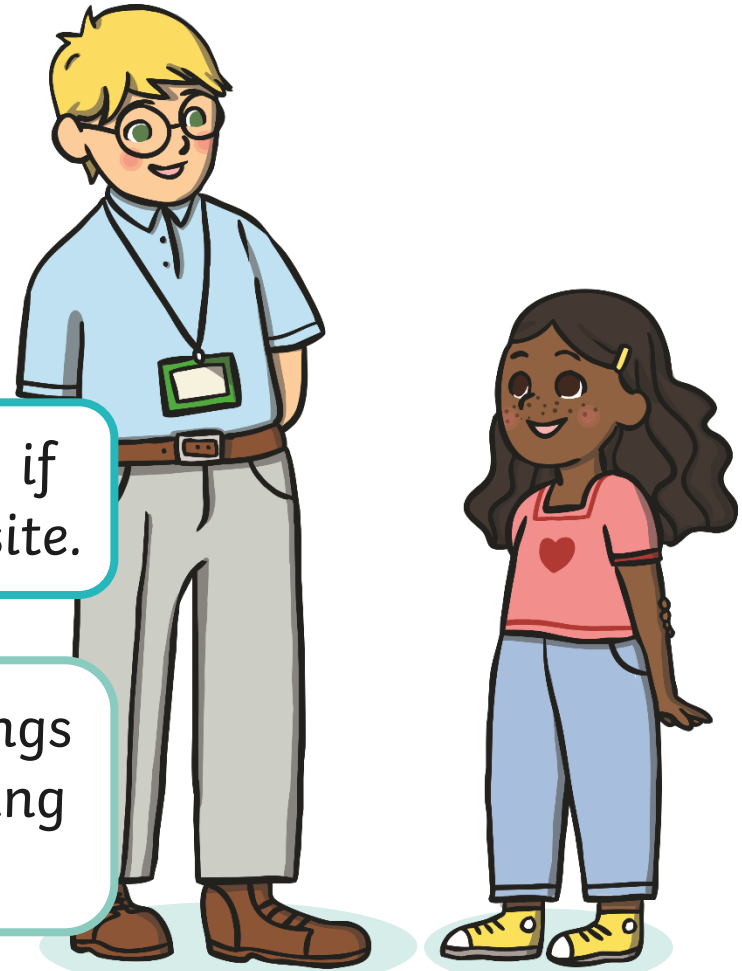

Remember, anyone can add things to the internet and not everything is suitable for children.



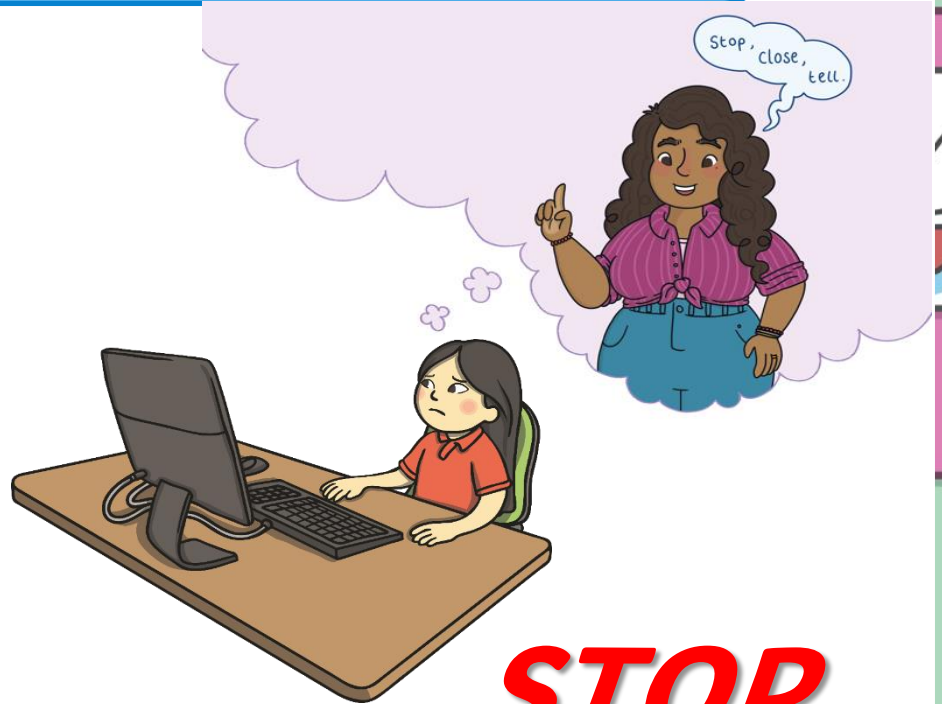

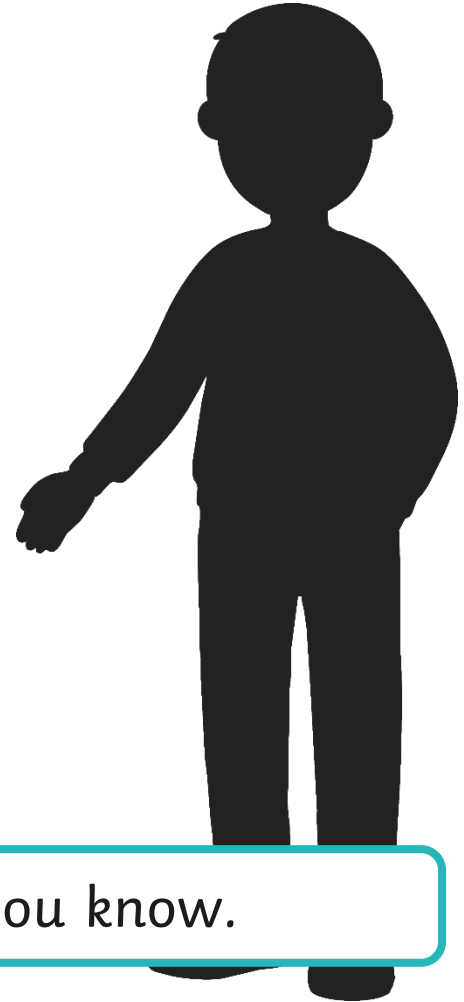
How to Stay Safe on the Internet
