

Your Child's Learning:

In English this half term the children will be learning to:

- Write a poem.
- Read using a range of strategies - Reading Toolkit.
- Say out loud what they are going to write about.
- Discuss new word meanings.
- Sequence sentences to form a short narrative.

Read with your child as often as possible. This does not always have to be their school book. Each time you share a book at home please record this in your child's blue diary as they will get awarded dojos.

In maths this half term the children will be learning:

- Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-), and equals (=) signs.
- Add and subtract one digit numbers to 10, including 0.
- Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 10.
- Use part-whole method to find number fact families (number bonds).

Additionally, during the half term your child needs to choose and complete at least 2 of the following tasks. These can be brought into school during the half term.
